## **OUR RECORD**

A repertoire of our most successful events

#### **Propel: University Admission Webinars**

A three-part webinar held in winter 2018. Each day focused on one type of undergraduate program: business, STEM, and music. Our speakers included Academic Coach and Harvard PhD Candidate Zamyla Chan, and former Berklee College of Music student Dermot O'Halloran.

#### Tell the Music of Education: Protect Music Ed!

We created a video to advocate for public music education in Ontario. We acquired over 80 minutes of footage from more than 23 schools, as well as support from 27 organizations, including the Coalition for Music Education, the Federation of Canadian Secondary Students, and Scarborough Arts. The video reached nearly 17.4K people and received more than 5.5K views on Facebook. Refer to Appendix A for more information on this video.

#### Young Leader in Music Award

This award was created to award individuals in the GTA who are creating change in their communities through music. We received approximately 20 applications and awarded 3 individuals with \$280 total in prize money. Vanessa Ng, our first place winner, was honoured for her commitment to her students during her co-op placement.



#### Transpose: An Innovation in Music Conference

We held a music conference on June 9, 2019 from 10AM-5PM at 123 Edward Street. The focus of the conference was to explore the interdisciplinary applications of music and how it is creating a better world, not just for musical performers.



Wendy Wei

**Wendy Wei**, a successful business student turned music photographer, spoke about how she took her life in another direction after doing freelance photoshoots at a local karaoke bar. Since then, she's worked for high-profile clients like Tencent Entertainment, Taylor Swift, and Justin Timberlake.



Arjun Bali

**Arjun Bali**, the co-founder of Sodatone, a platform that uses machine learning to help the music industry identify the highest potential emerging artists. It was acquired by Warner Music Group in early 2018, making it the first-ever AI acquisition by the traditional music industry.



Robert Wilson

**Robert Wilson**, the founder of an artist development & media company called Cats Cove Media, highlighted how it isn't just about music, but about everything and everyone's relationship with the music. It's about the belief in something so engaging that you pour your heart and soul into it — as each project deserves nothing less. It's about the goal of putting love into the music industry.

Gagan Singh is an award-winning Soundtrack Composer, Record Producer, Multi-Instrumentalist and Talent Executive. Born and raised in Toronto, Gagan began playing Indian Classical Tabla, before learning Western Classical as well as contemporary musical styles. He went on to study at the University of Toronto, graduating with a focus on Music Composition for Media as well as Arts & Entertainment Management.


